The course:

If Ashridge Golf Course is new to you, you won't be disappointed, the club has regularly featured in the top 100 golf courses in the UK. Measuring 6,635 yards and with a par of 72, the course has been fairly described as encouraging to the average golfer whilst thought provoking to the good player.

Situated in an "area of outstanding natural beauty" on the edge of the Chiltern Hills and within 40 miles of central London, Ashridge Golf club has long been associated with warm hospitality and the very best golfing traditions. The Autumn colours in October are spectacular in this heavily wooded landscape. The local deer will quietly watch your putting skills on the green!

Once the golf is over, relax and enjoy dinner with guest speakers.

Dress code:

After 6.00pm, jackets and appropriate neckwear are required to be worn in the dining room and Club lounges (except in the Spike bar). Any form of training shoes, denim jeans, track suits and T shirts are not permitted on the course or in the Clubhouse. Shorts may be worn but they must be tailored and may only be worn with knee length socks with a turnover top. Shorts are not allowed in the dining room or lounges. Golf shoes, whether studded or rubber soles, must not be worn in the main public rooms of the Clubhouse (except in the Spike bar).
